Dear Residents, Families and Team Members of Auburn Hill Senior Living,

I wanted to update you on our COVID status here at Auburn Hill. Unfortunately, we have 4 additional team members who have tested positive for COVID. These team members are in quarantine at home. We have completed our second round of testing for all residents. Unfortunately, we have one memory care resident who has positive test results. The family has been notified. All other residents have negative test results.

At this point our plan is to retest all residents in 5-7 days or as indicated by our daily screenings of the residents. We have notified the department of health and will adjust our plan based on their recommendations. We have PPE available and in place for team members.

Team members are required to wear masks while in the community. As a reminder, visitors are required to wear masks while entering the community and may remove them once in the apartments if both parties are vaccinated. Please remember that visitations must occur in the apartments or outside. Restrictions for visitation in common areas, activities, and dining are still in place. Please do not visit the community if you are experiencing any signs or symptoms of COVID.
