Good Afternoon Residents, Families, and Team,

I hope everyone found time to enjoy some of the Thanksgiving Day. I wanted to send an update to you about the COVID-19 status here at Auburn Hill.

Because of both the presence of symptoms, or known possibility of exposure, additional testing took place for a handful of individuals. We do have some additional positive cases here at Auburn Hill to report. Our current total is 3 positive residents (1 Memory Care, 2 Assisted Living) and 5 positive team members. The family members of the residents who tested positive are already aware. The team members who tested positive will not return to work until they have met their quarantine obligations.

We remain in contact with the Virginia Department of Health (VDH) for any additional guidance or changes that need to be made here at the community. At the direction of VDH, we have converted N95 use.

The Virginia Department of Health is coordinating testing for all residents and team members with the National Guard. We are anticipating testing to occur on Tuesday or Wednesday of next week. If the dates change I will send out an updated notification to you.

In the meantime, we will continue to screen residents and team members for signs and symptoms of COVID-19 and proceed as appropriate.

I have received many incredible messages from families and I would like to thank you for the kind words of encouragement and support. We appreciate your care and concern. If you have any questions please feel free to contact us.
